



This new partnership will provide short term and long-term residents of Christ the King Manor to have access to a dedicated Respiratory Therapist on site along with Dr. Bansal and his colleagues. Pulmonary services are available to support residents with acute and chronic conditions such as COPD, Asthma, Sleep Apnea, Pneumonias, Lung Cancer, and Respiratory Failure.

Administrator, Paula Felton-Werner, stated, "Adding Dr. Bansal and his respiratory therapy team is a wonderful opportunity for Christ the King Manor to expand the services offered to our current and future residents." She also added, "We want to continue to expand our specialty services and adding a Pulmonary Specialty program will help support the needs of our entire campus."

With a limited number of senior living facilities in the area to offer Pulmonary services, Christ the King Manor is thrilled with this new endeavor that will support the current growing needs within the campus and surrounding areas.
