SOCIAL SERVICES MONTH



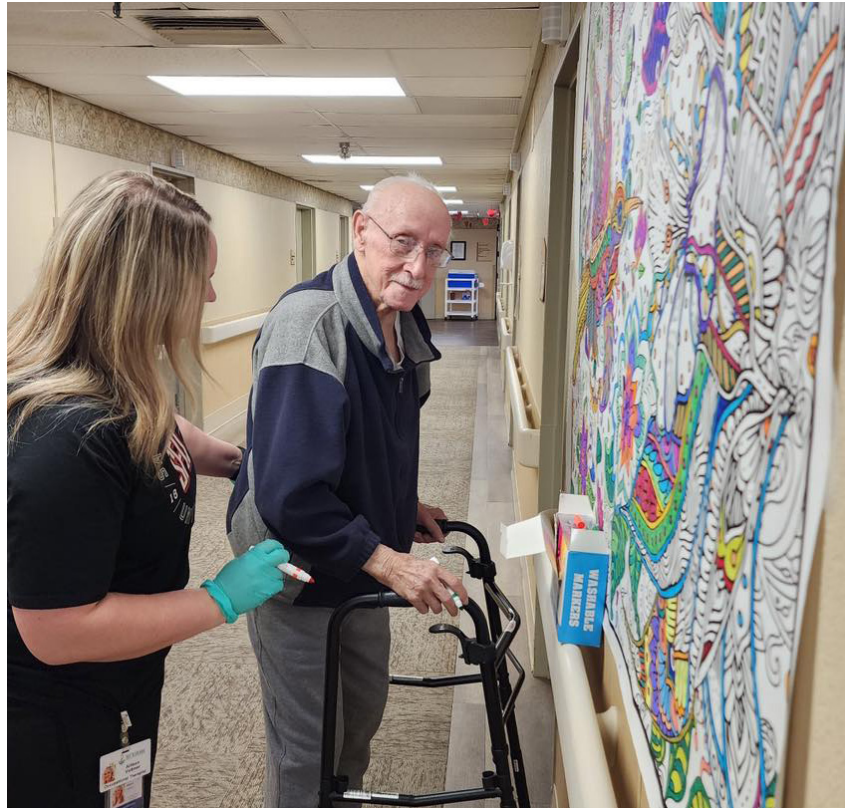
March is Social Services
